

## **Enrichment Offer at Oasis Academy Putney**

Here at Oasis Academy Putney, we aim to provide all children with a challenging and stimulating curriculum. The enrichment provision will be delivered through workshops across the academic year where they will focus on tasks that are stretching and demanding. These workshops will create an environment whereby the pupils can engage in a higher and deeper level of understanding.

The enrichment provision we will be offering to our highest attainers will excite and intrigue them and provide them with knowledge that they can then share with their peers in the classroom; the additional input will not only benefit these pupils but benefits all pupils; we anticipate that the knowledge pupils acquire from our enrichment workshops will be feed beautifully back into the classroom where they can share all of they have learnt through meaningful partner talk and high-quality classroom discussion.

Some children may be performing at a very high standard in all of these subjects and will therefore be chosen for all three groups. We are committed to ensuring that there is transparency and equity in the allocation of places to the groups.

### Selection for the enrichment programme

The Senior Leadership Team have agreed that the following criteria will be used to allocate places in these enrichment sessions:

- Pupils' end of year tests scores.
- Pupils' end of year teacher assessment.
- Class teachers' views of pupils' capacity to access and engage with the challenging material presented.

The enrichment workshops we will be running will be as follows:




## Writing Workshop

This is a highly creative, engaging writing session where the children will use a 'hook' as a stimulus for writing. We will look closely at a range of lenses using our 'Write Stuff' approach and explore a range of literary devices to create excellent pieces of high-quality writing. Following on from these sessions, it will be really important that the work produced is celebrated at home and in school.

## Mathematical Enquiry



This is a structured course with a focus on mathematical enquiry, problem solving, using and applying logic and formulating generalisations based on evidence.



The aim of this workshop is to support pupils in the development of the following skills:

- **Enquiry:** defining a problem; predicting an outcome; testing a conclusion
- **Creative thinking:** generating and extending ideas; suggesting a hypothesis; looking for alternative outcomes.
- **Reasoning:** making and explaining deductions; reaching decisions informed by evidence.
- **Evaluation:** evaluating evidence and reaching conclusions; making generalisations.

## Scientific Enquiry



The aim of the programme is to accelerate pupils' scientific enquiry skills. All learning involves practical investigations and pupils will have the opportunities to present their finding at the end of the workshop.
