Welcome to Year 4. We hope you have had a restful summer break and are looking forward to starting the new term. Our theme this term is 'Who am I? and Who am I becoming?'

Please read below to see what we will be exploring this half term in each of the subject areas.

As writers we will be learning to...

We will be focussing on narrative and non-fiction writing this term. We will be using the following texts as our stimulus – 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory' and 'Beautifully Different and Wonderfully the Same'. We will be writing a narrative piece and a poetry piece of writing. We will also be focussing on grammar, spelling, and handwriting throughout the term. We will be using the 'Writing Rainbow' as our focus learning points and building on our prior learning.



As readers we will be learning to...

We will continue practising the VIPERS skills: vocabulary, inferencing, predicting, explaining, retrieving, and summarising through a range of texts.

We will be studying the following texts:

Maggie Dooley
What is bullying?
The Skeleton
Journey to the cnetre of your body
The Raven and the Crow
A letter home.

As mathematicians we will be learning to...

Use place value and addition and subtraction.

Place value:

- Represent and partition numbers to 1000
- Represent and partition numbers to 10,000
- Find 1,10,100,1000 more or less
- Estimate, compare and order numbers to 10,000
- Roman numerals
- Round to the nearest 10, 100, 1000

Addition and Subtraction:

- Add and subtract 1s, 10s, 100s 1000s
- Add up to two 4-digit numbers no exchanging, with exchanging and with more than one exchange.
- Subtract tw0 4-digit numbers no exchanging, with exchanging and with more than one exchange.
- Efficient subtraction
- Estimating
- Checking strategies

- Degrees and qualities of lght and dark
- Texture with line and shape

Homework

Children will be given a half term overview for homework. These will include a maths, English/topic and spelling section. Homework will go out on <u>Fridays</u> and must be handed in by the following <u>Wednesday</u>.

Maths-There will be a mixture of homework activities that will be completed in books and on Sumdog.

English/topic – There will be a mixture of homework activities that will be completed in books and creatively.

Reading – All children will take a reading book home at the appropriate level. Please ensure that you are reading daily and completing the reading record. Books can be accessed online too through Access It.

Spelling – All children will be sent home spellings each week, and they will be tested weekly. There will also be a spelling challenge set on Spelling Shed which matches the words they will be learning.

Times tables – Children will also be encouraged to focus on their times tables throughout the year using Sumdog and Maths Factor. The children must learn all of the times tables up to x12.

Notices and reminders

- PE is on Wednesday and Fridays. Please ensure that your child is sent into school with the correct kit on those days.
- Children should be reading daily either independently or with you. This must be recorded by them/you in their reading records. These will be checked weekly.
- Ensure your child brings in their iPads, reading records and reading books every day.
