RHYTHM READING

Let's start with a new rhythm reading warm up.

NOTE – remember we say **Ta-ah** instead of **To-e**

SAY the name as you clap/tap/play the rhythm

PITCH – the high and low sounds, and some in the middle!

Mountains are perfect for explaining pitch with a picture.

You have the **bottom** of the mountain, a **low note** and then as you go up to the top of the mountain the notes get **higher**, until you reach the **top**, the very **highest sound!**

ACTIVITY

Fill three glasses with different amounts of water.

Tap the side of them (gently) with a spoon/pen. They should all sound different.

Order them from Low to high pitch.

Now draw your own mountains, or copy the shape of the ones in the clip.

Follow the outline of the mountain to tell you if it is low, medium or high, and **play the shape of the pitch** on your glasses/bottles.

Ask someone else to draw you different shaped mountain ranges for you to play the pitch.

Challenge them to play your mountain pitch shapes.
